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KazNARU PARTICIPATES IN THE PROFESSIONAL GARDENS EXHIBITION IN AKTOBE



♦ The large-scale educational exhibition *"Study in Kazakhstan"* took place in the western regions of the country from *April 3 to April 12, 2025, organized by the **Ministry of Science and Higher Education. This initiative contributes to raising awareness of higher education opportunities (*SDG 4: Quality Education).

During the exhibition, graduates had the unique opportunity to meet directly with representatives of leading Kazakhstani universities and branches of international high schools, gain insights about *UNT-2025* and available grants, and learn strategies for successfully passing *IELTS* exams.

- ♦ One of the highlights was the major event titled *"Supporting Talented Youth and Making Higher Education Accessible", organized by the **Kazakh National Agrarian Research University (KazNARU). This event was held at the **Students Palace of Zhubanov University, emphasizing inclusivity and equal access to education (*SDG 10: Reduced Inequalities).
- ✓ During the event, the *Director of the KazNARU Admission Commission, Professor **Ainur Kairbayeva*, along with a team of experts, introduced high school students from Aktobe city and region to the university's recent achievements in becoming a modern research-focused institution.
- ✓ In 2024, KazNARU established the *Faculty of Water Resources. Under the support of the Head of State, a branch of the **Tashkent Institute of Irrigation and Agricultural Mechanization Engineers* was also launched. These initiatives train specialists in water management through dual-degree programs, addressing critical issues like water conservation and sustainability (SDG 6: Clean Water and Sanitation and SDG 13: Climate Action).
- ✓ Furthermore, attendees were introduced to new educational opportunities, updated admission policies, grant programs, and joint initiatives with foreign partner universities. KazNARU also offers opportunities for internships through its *"Dual Education" system, enhancing practical skills and fostering professional readiness (*SDG 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth). For instance, seven

dual-degree programs are currently being implemented in collaboration with leading international educational centers.

✓ Professor Ainur Kairbayeva highlighted: *"In 2025, 35 budget seats have been allocated for graduates of the Aktobe region. Our aim is to showcase our advanced practices in preparing highly qualified professionals for the agricultural sector, which is essential for future development. Participants were presented with video materials and additional brochures to provide further insights. Many attendees expressed interest in applying for grants at KazNARU, particularly in fields like IT engineering and veterinary sciences."* This aligns with SDG 4: Quality Education and SDG 2: Zero Hunger by fostering innovation and expertise in agriculture and related fields.
