Purpose of the University:

Development of research and innovation activities of the University in accordance with the priorities of scientific, technical and socio-economic development of the country, improving the quality of education, material and technical base, formation of a highly cultured, socially responsible personality of the graduate.

System of goals:

- transformation of KazNARU into an agrarian research university of international level;
