









Meeting of Students with APOLLO e. V. (Germany) Representatives at KazNARU

On March 26, 2025, a meeting was held at the Kazakh National Agrarian Research University (KazNARU) with representatives of APOLLO e. V. – the Association for Cooperation in Ecology, Agriculture, and Rural Development (Germany).

The program is aimed at supporting students in the agricultural field. During the meeting, it was announced that 13 KazNARU students had successfully passed the selection process and were given the opportunity to undertake an internship in Germany.

The main goal of the event was to introduce students to international internship opportunities, provide information about the farms where they will be placed, assess their German language proficiency, and answer their questions.

To conduct the meeting, APOLLO e. V. Representative Alexandra Sitenko visited KazNARU. She introduced students to the farms where they would be doing their internships and discussed key organizational matters.

The internship in Germany is fully funded: travel expenses, accommodation, German language courses, and visa support are covered by APOLLO e. V.
